Can we, as iridologists provide preventative advice in the consultation on Age-related Macular Degeneration (ARMD)? Marian Baartz MSc, MAR, FGNI, RNT



Marian Baartz holds a Masters in Public Health, Nutritional Therapy and Healthcare and works in adult education as a teacher and NVQ assessor of Reflexology, Nutritional therapy and Iridology. She also teaches Iridology at The University of Westminster in London and has studied with Klaus Mika, Marco Zupan, Jarozycck, and Serge Jurasunas. She is fluent in Dutch, French and German and has translated several iridology books for her own knowledge. Marian is the director of her own Guild accredited Iridology school and practices in Surrey. In her practice Marian combines the analysis of the Iris, tongue, face, nails, reflexology and organ symptoms to enable her to form an in depth picture as to the health of the client. It was during a recent consultation that Marian was faced with a client diagnosed as having Age Related Macular Degeneration, a condition that can lead to loss of sight. Marian's lecture will provide an insight into the investigation of preventative measurements for ARMD. It will also provide information on simple tests that subjects can take to measure early symptoms and monitor their progress.

Riding the Heart-Voice-Thyroid Vector: Language and Paradigm in the Iridology Consultation Peter Jackson-Main MA, FAMH, FGNI



Peter Jackson-Main became involved with Iridology shortly after leaving university in the 70's, when a range of personal health problems prompted him to seek alternative advice. After many years of research and study in various disciplines, he eventually came full circle to Natural Healing, Herbal Medicine and Iridology, and currently practices in Cambridge, Lancashire and London. For the past thirteen years he has been in great demand for his skills as a teacher and trainer, and has lectured widely in the UK, Ireland and the Caribbean. His book *Practical Iridology* (2004) is now published in eleven languages and is in its second imprint.

Peter has been significantly involved with the development of the herbal profession in the UK, as a founder member and chairman for many years of the Association of Master Herbalists, and a director and former secretary of the European Herbal and Traditional Medicine Practitioners Association (EHTPA). His research interests are currently in multidimensional Iridology and PNEI, and in the development and exposition of the emerging *Western* paradigm of holistic medicine, which he sees as a necessary cultural development in response to the dominant biomedical discourse and the global commercialisation of medicine.

Hakim M. Salim Khan has been in practice since 1978 in Leicester and London, as a Consultant Herbal Physician, and Iridologist. Salim is a founder member, fellow of the Guild and a member of its Ethics Committee. He will be known to most GNI members as he has been a regular attendee at the Guild's symposiums for many years. He is the founder and director of The Mohsin Institute, which has become the leading organisation for practice, education, research and training in the wisdom, science and practice of Eastern (Tibb) Medicine. Salim's successful methods of treatment have been broadcast in a BBC television documentary and his works have been on display in London at the Science Museum and the Wellcome Institute. He is also director of research and development for Mohsin Health Products, the only company that produces high quality Unani herbal supplements in the U.K.

Salim's lecture will be practice-based, sharing his clinical experience as to how he uses iris analysis, energetic understanding of body type and temperament (mizaj), plus nutrition and herbs to facilitate this 'big issue' of our time.
